

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution Nos. 70-185 and 70-190, \$25,000.00 was advanced to the Community Action Program from Tribal Herd funds, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Herd was to be reimbursed this said sum of money as soon as the Federal Government funded the Community Action Program, and


WHEREAS, it is anticipated that this money will be forthcoming soon, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Business Office is in dire need of additional office space.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$12,000.00 to defray the cost of building an addition to the Tribal Business Office.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said sum of \$12,000.00 is to be secured from the repayment by the Community Action Program of the money advanced to the Community Action Program by the Tribe.

The foregoing Resolution was on February 3, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
