FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Forestry Committee presented to the Tribal Council that the sale of two hundred (200) silver tip blue spruce trees to the Nevada School for Girls, and


WHEREAS, this is a fine public relations gesture.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Agency Forester is hereby authorized to sell to the Nevada School for Girls, two hundred (200) silver tip blue spruce trees for the sum of \$1.00 per tree.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said trees would be transplanted in Nevada.

The foregoing resolution was on February 3, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
