

RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, four of the pickups used by the Police Department have mileage of approximately 150,000 miles, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the Police Department now secure these said four pickups for replacements.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Police Department is hereby authorized to spend the sum of \$11,683.72 to purchase the said vehicles.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this sum of \$11,683.72 be paid from funds budgeted for the Fiscal Year 71-72.

The foregoing resolution was on February 4, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
