FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Ronnie Lupe has served as Tribal Chairman for four years and Council member for two years, and


WHEREAS, for the past six months, he has been Legislative Coordinator of the Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Council believes that he is well qualified to fill Superintendent's position of the Indian Agency.

BE IT RESOLVED that Ronnie Lupe is hereby recommended by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe to fill that Superintendency of the Fort Apache Indian Agency position recently vacated by Mr. Robert E. Robinson.

The foregoing resolution was on February 4, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
