

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the lease on the White Mountain Scenic Railroad has expired
as of December 31, 1970, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is in the process of studying
the feasibility of connecting the railroad operation to the
recreation potential of the reservation together, and

WHEREAS, additional time is needed for the feasibility study and
forming a program satisfactory to the Tribe that will
take the greater part of the year 1971.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache
Tribe that in order to grant the time required for the
study that Lease No. 14-20-0H52-33 to the White Mountain
Scenic Railroad be extended and will expire on December 31,
1971.

The foregoing resolution was on March 3, 1971 duly adopted by a
vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the
White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it
by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-
Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved
by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to
Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
