

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the lease between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Employment Security Commission of Arizona expired on March 1, 1971, and

WHEREAS, the Employment Security Commission of Arizona has requested a new lease for a two-year period which will allow them to maintain an office at the present location until they can make arrangements to furnish better building facilities at a new location already designated by the Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, this lease is exactly the same as the previous lease with one exception, i.e. inclusion of a 60-day cancellation clause which will allow them to enter into a new lease when they move to the new location.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman is hereby authorized to execute a lease containing the 60-day cancellation clause with the Employment Security Commission of Arizona for a two-year period beginning March 1, 1971 at a rental rate of \$5.00 per month.

The foregoing resolution was on March 3, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 2, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
