

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 70-112 dated July 9, 1970, authorized the Tribe to enter into a contract with the Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc., for the construction of a power line into the Sunrise Ski Complex, and


WHEREAS, the Tribe's contribution for the proposed construction was \$62,800.00, and


WHEREAS, the construction cost were higher than anticipated, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe wishes to appropriate an additional \$6,950.55 to pay the total construction cost.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the sum of \$6,950.55 be appropriated from the Contingency Fund to pay in full the construction cost to Navopache Electric Cooperative, Inc., for the cost of construction of the power line to the Sunrise Ski Complex.

The foregoing resolution was on March 3, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1. (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
