

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribe desires to encourage thriftiness for its people and employees, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe desires to promote the White Mountain Federal Credit Union as being a local facility to encourage savings by the Indian people.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Business Office is authorized to make salary savings deductions from Tribal employees to the White Mountain Federal Credit Union.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that each deduction for savings be charged fourteen cents (14¢) to cover Tribal accounting cost and this cost of accounting is to be borne by the Credit Union.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all saving deductions are voluntary and at the option of the employee and may be started or cancelled upon the presentation to the Tribal Treasurer the prescribed signed affidavits to authorize the Tribal Treasurer to make the saving deductions or cancel said deductions.

The foregoing resolution was on March 3, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 5 for and 3 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
