



RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 70-188 established the White Mountain Apache Child Protective Agency, and
- WHEREAS, said resolution provided, among other things, that the Protective Agency would submit to the Tribal Council, Agency procedures for approval by the council, and
- WHEREAS, these Child Protective Agency Procedures were presented to, read by and discussed among the council.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Child Protective Agency Procedures, a copy of which is attached hereto marked, Exhibit A and by reference made a part hereof, is hereby approved.

The foregoing resolution was on April 7, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
