

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Jimmy Nunn, the Engineer for the Sunrise Complex recommended to the Tribal Council that it approve the installation of a sprinkler system in the facilities now being constructed at Sunrise even though Phase II funding has not as yet been approved by EDA, and


WHEREAS, by the installation of this sprinkler system, the savings in the fire insurance cost would pay for the installation in approximately three years, and

WHEREAS, the sprinkler system is an absolute, necessary fire protection requirement.

BE IT RESOLVED that the engineering firm of Haver, Nunn and Nelson is hereby authorized and directed, prior to the approval by EDA of Phase II, to install a sprinkler system in the facilities now being constructed at the lodge and restaurant site of the Sunrise Complex.

The foregoing resolution was on April 7, 1971 duly adopted lby a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
