

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the normal schedule of partial payments to contractors and engineers is not compatible with the provision of grant and loan funds by the Economic Development Administration (EDA), and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the Tribe maintain good working relationship with its contractors and engineers.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council directs the Chairman and Treasurer to establish as necessary and as possible with whatever funds are available, Interim Financing for EDA Projects 714, 604 and 643, with the understanding that all Tribal funds used for this purpose are to be replaced intact as EDA grants and loans are processed.

The foregoing resolution was on April 7, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
