

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the U. S. Public Health Service has agreed to construct the water system for the McNary Indian Community and limited to the McNary Mutual-Help Housing Project, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, a resolution requesting the U. S. Public Health Service to construct the water system for the McNary Mutual-Help Housing Project has been adopted by the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority, and

WHEREAS, an agreement has been requested by the U. S. Public Health Service by and between the U. S. Public Health Service and the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority; such agreement having been read to the Tribal Council.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is hereby authorized to execute the agreement for the construction of water supply facilities in the McNary Indian Community for the McNary Mutual-Help Housing Project.

The foregoing resolution was on April 14, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
