

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the extremely dry weather has caused critical conditions on the tribal cattle range, and

WHEREAS, the Agricultural Conservation Program, USDA, has declared this to be a disaster area and has made funds available on an 80-20 basis to alleviate this condition, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council feels that it is essential that some action be taken at once.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman and the Tribal Treasurer are hereby authorized to spend \$10,000.00 from the 1970-1971 contingency fund and \$10,000.00 from the 1971-1972 contingency fund to implement corrective measures on the tribal range land.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman have prepared the necessary documents to apply to the Federal Government for funds to help remedy this condition.

The foregoing resolution was on April 14, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
