

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, many of the tribal buildings on the reservation are without fire extinguishers, and

WHEREAS, there is a great need for these fire extinguishers.

BE IT RESOLVED there is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit the sum of \$900.00 to purchase twenty (20) fire extinguishers.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these fire extinguishers achieve the White Mountain Apache Tribal identifying labels.

The foregoing resolution was on May 5, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
