


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the University of Arizona has proposed a study on the feasibility of growing Christmas trees on the reservation, and

WHEREAS, there are two tribal members, Mr. Phillip Stago, Sr. and Mrs. Harry Brewer, who have land assignments on the reservation and who are willing to cooperate with the University of Arizona on this project.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe concurs in and approves this proposed research project.

The foregoing resolution was on May 5, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1(i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
