

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Resolution No. 70-130 approved the expenditure of \$3,000.00 from the Contingency Fund to be used as matching funds for a Mental Health Program, and

WHEREAS, these funds were not used during fiscal year 1970-71 and were returned to the general fund of the Tribe on April 30, 1971, and

WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Health, Education and Welfare Committee requested that the Tribal Council again approve the expenditure of \$3,000.00 for a Mental Health Program.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the sum of \$3,000.00 is appropriated from the 1971-72 Contingency Fund to be used as matching funds for a Mental Health Program.

The foregoing resolution was on May 5, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
