

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Northfork Spruce Logging Unit is included in the five-year timber sale program, and

WHEREAS, the timber from this unit is part of the allowable annual cut.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Northfork Spruce Logging Unit, as presented in the Forest Officer's Report and Proposed Contract covering the recommended sale of this timber and subject to minor changes and administrative adjustments by the Approving Officer, be sold to the Fort Apache Timber Company. The rate charged for stumpage is to be adjusted monthly as specified in Tribal Resolution No. 69-103 and Area Director's memorandum of August 23, 1969.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary are authorized to execute the contract and related documents necessary to administer the sale of the timber for and on behalf of this council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED a deduction not to exceed twenty five percent (25%) of the gross receipts received from the purchaser will be accrued in the road expense account. This accrual will continue until the Road Expense Account is funded to the extent required to provide the road construction fund reserve authorized by the tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED a rehabilitation plan approved by the Tribal Council and the Approving Officer will be prepared. This plan will detail the proposed expenditures and work to be accomplished. The work to be accomplished will be of such a nature to restore the clear cut logged areas to a productive forest. If funds for this rehabilitation are not available from the government, the Tribe will budget funds for this program.

The foregoing Resolution was on June 9, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
