

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe enacted Ordinance No. 47 on January 13, 1963 establishing the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority in order to eliminate unsafe and unsanitary housing conditions on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority desires to provide decent, safe and sanitary housing for families of low income on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and


WHEREAS, the Housing Assistance Administration has approved a Program Reservation for 65 Low-Rent Dwelling Units, 60 Remote-Type Dwelling Units and 75 Mutual-Help Dwelling Units to be developed pursuant to the U. S. Housing Act of 1937, and

WHEREAS, it is understood that, this is not a legal obligation but a statement of determination by the Housing Assistance Administration, subject to fulfillment of all requirements of law, to enter into a new or amended Preliminary Loan Contract or Annual Contributions Contract covering the number of units reserved, or such lesser number as may be consistent with the Authority of the Housing Assistance Administration to enter into such Contracts.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, that the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority is hereby authorized and directed to execute all necessary documents to effectuate the development of the 65 Low-Rent Dwelling Units, 60 Remote-Type Dwelling Units and 75 Mutual-Help Dwelling Units.

The foregoing resolution was on June 9, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
