

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs has offered to make a grant to the White Mountain Apache Tribe for the purpose of administering a General Assistance program to employable eligible persons so that they may be employed while receiving a general assistance grant, and

WHEREAS, such employment would provide training for the individual and public works for the community.

BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council agrees to accept a grant for a work training program and agrees to enter into the attached agreement and to cooperate with the Bureau of Indian Affairs in the administration of the program including the Public Works aspect of the program and including Workmen's Compensation for participants.

The foregoing resolution was on June 9, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
