

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council requested the Indian Health Service to construct domestic water supply and waste disposal facilities to serve the residents in the Upper East Fork Community, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the project is now completed, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe, when making its request for the construction of these facilities, agreed to accept all of the supplies, materials and equipment appertaining to said facility and to further maintain and operate said facility.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman, for and on behalf of the Tribal Council, is hereby authorized and directed to sign the transfer agreement between the United States of America, acting through the Indian Health Service, Department of Health, Education and Welfare, Project No. PH 69-118, said agreement covering the transfer of the domestic water supply and waste disposal facilities East Fork Community to the tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on July 7, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
