


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council requested the Indian Health Service to furnish domestic water supply and waste disposal facility to serve the Mutual Help Indian Homes in the Whiteriver Community, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe, when making its request, agreed to accept the facilities and all property appertaining thereto and to maintain said facilities.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman for and on behalf of the Tribal Council is hereby authorized and directed to sign that certain transfer agreement between the Indian Health Service, Department of Health, Education and Welfare, the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority and the White Mountain Apache Tribe, said transfer agreement being Project No. PH 70-949 MH covering the transfer and acceptance of the water supply and waste disposal facilities of the Mutual-Help Indian homes in the Whiteriver Community, Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on July 7, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
