

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Tribal Council requested the Indian Health Service to provide domestic water supply and waste disposal facilities to serve the Indian homes in the Whiteriver Community housing for the elderly and infirm project and the Whiteriver Housing Improvement Program, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe, when making its request, agreed to accept a transfer of all of the facilities and to be responsible for the maintenance thereof, and

WHEREAS, the said project is now completed.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman, for and on behalf of the Tribal Council, is hereby authorized and directed to execute that certain transfer agreement between the Indian Health Service, Department of Health, Education and Welfare and the White Mountain Apache Tribe, Project No. PH 67-996 ELD.

The foregoing resolution was on July 7, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
