

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Plan of Operation for the White Mountain Apache Enterprises was approved by the Tribal Council on April 5, 1967 by Resolution No. 67-57, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the White Mountain Apache Enterprises recently reviewed the Plan of Operation and recommended certain amendments to the Plan, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council agrees that the amendments recommended by the Board of Directors will result in a more efficient operation of the White Mountain Apache Enterprises.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the amendments as presented are hereby approved and are to be incorporated along with the Conditions of Approval of the Area Director dated May 22, 1967 and June 2, 1967 into a Revised Plan of Operation for the White Mountain Apache Enterprises.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tribal Council is hereby authorized to sign the Revised Plan of Operation for the White Mountain Apache Enterprises and to accept any conditions of approval that may be requested by the Area Director.

The foregoing resolution was on July 7, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
