RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise is charged with the responsibility of regulating hunting and fishing by non-members on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the sale of hunting and fishing permits is an important source of revenue for the Enterprise, and

WHEREAS, there are huntable animals surplus to the needs of tribal members, and

WHEREAS, the Enterprise Board of Directors has made recommendations to the Tribal Council.

BE IT RESOLVED that the attached non-member hunting regulations, seasons, bag limits and fee schedules be approved for 1971/72.

The foregoing resolution was on July 8, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

 Season Dates : Rabbit - year long

 Permit Cost : \$3.00
6. BLUE GROUSE & BANDTAIL PIGEONS  
 Season Dates : Grouse- September 4, 1971 - September 12, 1971, Inclusive  
 Pigeon - October 16, 1971 - October 24, 1971, Inclusive  
 Bag Limit : Grouse-3 per day or in possession  
 Pigeon- The same season dates and bag limits as those prescribed by the Arizona Game and Fish Commission.  
 Number of Permits : Unlimited  
 Permit Cost : \$4.00
7. PREDATORY ANIMALS  
 Season Dates: : Year round  
 Number of Permits : Unlimited  
 Permit Cost : \$12.00
8. GUIDE PERMIT  
 Season Dates : Year long  
 Number of Permits : Unlimited  
 Permit Cost : \$50.00
9. HUNTING DOG PERMIT (For bear, lion, and predatory animals)  
 Season Dates : January 1, 1971 - December 31, 1971  
 Number of Permits : Unlimited  
 Permit Cost : \$40.00
- NOTE: Application for hunting dog permits must be made at the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise office in Whiteriver.
10. CLOSED AREAS  
 The Hawley Lake Recreation area and the Hon-Dah Homesite area will be closed to all hunting including predators.  
 The I.D. Game Reserve will be closed to all hunting except for bear and predatory animals.
11. CAMPING REGULATIONS  
 All persons camping on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation must have a valid camping permit in their possession. This will apply to all hunters except holders of Fort Apache Elk or Antelope permits, who may camp free during the respective seasons.
12. GUIDES  
 Guides are not required for parties hunting on the Reservation. The White Mountain Recreation Enterprise does not operate a professional guide service. A list of competent outfitters and guides who are licensed to operate on the Reservation will be furnished upon request.
