

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the last survey of the north boundary line of the reservation has disclosed that there are certain non-member landowners who are trespassing on the reservation, and


WHEREAS, these said landowners have notified the Tribal Attorney that they are interested in leasing from the tribe these trespassed lands.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Superintendent is hereby requested to determine the appraised value of the lands involved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that after the values are established, the Tribal Attorney is to notify the lessees and inform the Tribal Council of the results of his negotiations.

The foregoing resolution was on July 8, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
