



RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Annual Tribal Fair is of great benefit to the White Mountain Apache people, and
- WHEREAS, tribal funds are needed to help defray the cost of the Tribal Fair, and
- WHEREAS, the sum of \$3,000.00 is needed to help defray the cost of this year's expenses, and
- WHEREAS, \$3,000.00 is needed for repairs and improvements of the grandstand, and
- WHEREAS, \$3,000.00 is needed to contract for the furnishing of rodeo stock, and
- WHEREAS, \$900.00 is needed to pay the outstanding bill for publication of last year's Fair Books.
- BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated out of the Tribal Contingency Account, the sum of \$9,900.00 to cover the above-mentioned expenditures.

The foregoing Resolution was on July 8, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
