


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Head Start Program is short some \$11,000.00 to take care of all the Apache children who are members of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the Head Start Program is of great benefit to the future education of the White Mountain Apache children, who are members of the Tribe.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in the U. S. Treasury in the sum of \$11,000.00 to defray the additional cost of operating the Head Start Program for the ensuing year.

The foregoing resolution was on July 8, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
