WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, James D. Sparks has neglected his duties as Manager of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise, and

WHEREAS, he occupies a tribally-owned house.


BE IT RESOLVED that Mr. James D. Sparks' employment as Manager of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise is hereby terminated as of the 25th day of June, 1971.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Lafe Altaha is hereby appointed as Acting Manager of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise until further order of the Tribal Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. Arch Penrod shall supervise and assist Mr. Lafe Altaha in his managership for the said enterprise.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Mr. James D. Sparks shall have five (5) days from the 12th day of July in which to vacate the tribally-owned house he now occupies located in Whiteriver, Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was on July 8, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
