

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the U. S. Indian Health Service has offered to furnish domestic water supply and adequate disposal waste facilities under Public Law 86-121 for twenty (20) Indian homes located near Fort Apache Timber Company, and

WHEREAS, the tribe has to enter into an agreement with said Health Service in order to secure these facilities, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Dietemann, Public Health Service, has explained to the council all of the pertinent conditions in said agreement.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby authorized to sign that certain Memorandum of Agreement, for and on behalf of the Tribe, between the United States of America acting through the Indian Health Service, Department of Health, Education and Welfare, and the White Mountain Apache Tribe covering the furnishing of domestic water supply and waste disposal facilities for twenty (20) Indian homes located at Fort Apache Timber Company, Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on July 7, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
