


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service of the Department of Health, Education and Welfare has completed the construction of the domestic water supply and waste disposal facilities to serve the thirty-five units in the Whiteriver Community, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council had requested that the said Indian Health Service construct said facilities and agreed in said request to accept a transfer of all of the said facilities.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby authorized and directed to sign, for and on behalf of the Tribal Council, the transfer agreement between the United States of America and the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority and the White Mountain Apache Tribe, Project No. PH 71-984 CLR covering the thirty five (35) low-rent housing units in the Whiteriver Community, Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on July 7, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
