

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council requested the Indian Health Service to provide domestic water supply and waste disposal facilities to serve the residents in the Fort Apache Junction Community, Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the project providing for said construction is now complete, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe, when making its request for the construction of these facilities, agreed to accept a transfer of the facilities together with all appurtenances thereto, materials, supplies and equipment provided for, and

WHEREAS, the said Indian Service is now desirous of assigning all of this property to the tribe,

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman, for and on behalf of the Tribal Council, is hereby authorized and directed to execute the transfer agreement between the United States of America acting through Indian Health Service, Department of Health, Education and Welfare and the White Mountain Apache Tribe, Project No. PH 70-943.

The foregoing resolution was on July 7, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
