

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Cutting Expiration Date for the Coulter Salvage Logging Unit, Contract No. H50C-1420-7271, approved by the Superintendent, December 18, 1970, between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the H. B. Hawkins Lumber Company expires June 30, 1971, and


WHEREAS, logging was limited by wet weather conditions until late April, 1971, permitting only 2½ months of logging, leaving about three million board feet of dead and down material to be cut, and

WHEREAS, the Purchaser, H. B. Hawkins, has requested an extension of the Cutting Expiration Date through December 31, 1971.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Coulter Salvage Contract Cutting Expiration Date be extended through December 31, 1971 and the date to complete all other contract obligations be December 31, 1971.

The foregoing resolution was on August 4, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
