

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise has had closed to fishing, Christmas Tree Lake and sections of Moon and Sun Creeks for the past year, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has attempted to establish an Apache Trout fishery and it is now considered to be established, and


WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to share this resource with the general public.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Christmas Tree Lake will be open for fishing September 1, 1971 through September 30, 1971.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following conditions must be made:

1. Season will be from 6:00 a.m. September 1, 1971 to 6:00 p.m. daily through September 30, 1971.
2. Only angling with artificial lures and flies be allowed.
3. The daily bag and possession limit of Apache Trout be three (3) fish.
4. Moon and Sun Creeks shall remain closed.
5. If harvest of Apache Trout is excessive, the Christmas Tree Lake fishery can be closed at any time during the open period at the option of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise.
6. White Mountain Recreation Enterprise is directed to station a warden at all times on the access road to the lake to collect information.

The foregoing resolution was on August 4, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
