

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there are now many different enterprises and other governmental sub-agencies on the reservation, and

WHEREAS, each of these enterprise or sub-agencies have innumerable committee meetings throughout the year, and

WHEREAS, it is imperative that accurate recording of these meetings be made.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby established a Pool Secretary's Position at an annual salary of \$5720.00 together with taxes and fringe benefits and office supplies in the amount of \$2280.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the above expenditures be paid from savings accrued due to the elimination of the Chairman's Administrative Assistant Position.

The foregoing resolution was on August 4, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
