

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe is in dire need of assistance to reduce the unemployment rate of its tribal members, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe contributes its own funds to programs designed to employ tribal members and reduce the unemployment rate, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe feels that these programs assist in lowering and upgrading of skills of tribal members, and

WHEREAS, there is now available Government Assistance within the "Emergency Employment Act of 1971."


BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby authorized and directed to file and sign any application necessary to qualify the tribe for any benefits emanating from the Emergency Employment Act of 1971.

The foregoing resolution was on September 3, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
