


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Mr. and Mrs. Stanley Wright had offered to sell their building, commonly used as a Beauty Shop and located at Whiteriver, Arizona, to the White Mountain Apache Tribe for the sum of not to exceed, \$5,000.00, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council and the Superintendent are of the opinion that the purchase of the building for this sum of money would be a good buy.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated the sum of not to exceed \$5,000.00, deposited in the U. S. Treasury, to purchase the building owned by Mr. and Mrs. Stanley Wright located in Whiteriver, Arizona.

The foregoing resolution was on September 21, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 3 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
